come from a family near Augsburg with a humble background. I did not have pocket money so I went to the Golf Club as a Caddy to make some money. A Club member kindly gave me four golf clubs, including a bent putter, so I started to play golf.

To everyone's astonishment, because I was unknown, I won a German professional event at Munich when I was sixteen. But then I got a strange illness called 'Yips'. Surgeons and athletes get it. One suffers from uncontrollable shakes in the hands that does not help putting. Then came some very tough training in the Air Force. I suffered back injuries and was in hospital. It seemed as if my

golfing career was over just when it was taking off.

After my military service, with perseverance and willpower, I got back to golf and in 1983 was winning some European tournaments. Finally, in 1985, I won the US Master's Tournament at Augusta, Georgia. I had reached the top! I also met and married Vikki, a gorgeous girl from Louisiana. Yet with all this success I felt an emptiness, a void.

Fame and money and marriage did not bring the joy I had hoped for.

One dav Bobby Clampett asked me to a Bible Study led by Larry Moody. We read about Nicodemus being told by lesus that he could not see or enter Heaven until he was born again by the Spirit of God. This is not a physical birth, but a spiritual birth. It comes to those who recognise that we have all sinned and so cannot enter heaven. The only solution is to ask lesus to forgive us, to take our sins and aive us His 'Robe of Righteousness.'

Heaven is a gift for those humble enough to ask for it.

So Vikki and I invited Jesus to be our Lord and Saviour. Gradually I found that the peace and joy I had longed for became real. I stopped swearing, did not become angry so easily, became more patient. I was a new creation, a child of God. WOW!

As a consequence God has blessed the work of my hands as He promises. I was Captain of the European Ryder Cup Team against USA in 2004. USA




were the firm favourites but we won by a $18\frac{1}{2}$:9½ record result. We gave thanks to God for a victory that seemed miraculous.

Life as a Christian has many trials and testings, but God promises to be with us and help us, and it is the only way to Eternal Life in Heaven. Most people go down the broad highway that ends in destruction. I hope that you will join Vikki and me by taking the narrow gate and the hard way that leads to Eternal Life.

How the Blind can See

Keith Oliver Olympic Biathlon Competitor



was born in Liverpool and lived my childhood with foster parents. When I finished school my education was very poor. I was a complete introvert. Later I heard one of my cross country team guys say "He can't half run, but he can't talk."

When I left school at 15 I worked in a factory before joining the Army about a year later as a Junior Soldier where my education improved. Before being posted to Germany I became the Army Cross Country Champion. I was encouraged to compete in the biathlon which is cross country skiing and shooting (a sport in which you need the stamina of a marathon runner and the marksmanship of a shooter). These sports became a major part of my life for 25 years.

I competed in three Olympics, 1972, '76 and '80 and I was a coach in the 1988 Olympics. I still have the best Olympic positions in the UK and was honoured to carry the flag at the 1980 Olympics closing ceremony. Later I was given the BEM for services to sport.

In 1979, on one of the summer training camps in Dorset, I went to church where I was impressed by the sincere preaching of Stephanie Grindley, the lay preacher. During a talk with her after the service she explained that Jesus Christ, God's son, came into our world to save us from our sinful nature that leads to Hell. We are all blind to this until we humble ourselves and ask Jesus to be our Lord and Saviour. He can then take our sins on the Cross and open the door to Heaven if we persevere in our new life. She then said "Do you want to become a Christian?" I said I would and she then helped me to invite Jesus into my heart.

About a week after becoming a Christian one of the national ski staff said to me that I had changed. He didn't know that God was changing my life. Now I was reading the Bible all the time and understanding it. The things I was doing wrong I now didn't seem to have the desire to do any more. It was a great feeling to know for sure that God had answered my simple prayer to become a Christian.

My wife Margaret soon became a Christian and we both got water Baptised at an Easter Convention in Germany which was organised by the Army Scripture Readers Association.



ootball was my God. Everything I did, all the decisions I made were geared towards my ambition of success and fame through football. Following my time at Charlton Athletic as a young footballer and my other experiences at Barnet FC and Reading FC I realised that football could be a hard and heartless industry and that fame and fortune does not make you happy.

I had always tried to be loyal and work hard for the clubs I played for but



had been treated harshly and unfairly. As a result I came to hate football and all it stood for. That really set me questioning the whole way of the world and its values.

Suddenly life didn't seem fair. What sort of race was it, and was it worth it? Out of

those feelings I had an urge to buy a Bible and go to church, but I didn't know where to go and I didn't know anybody.

When I came to Portsmouth FC I met

Darren Moore who was a Christian. He helped me in my decision to give my life to Jesus and since then I haven't looked back. At last I knew what real peace in my life was and my whole attitude to football

and people changed as God changed me on the inside. As my confidence in God rose my relationships improved and I even began to play without fear and as a result perform to a higher level than I could have ever imagined – I even became 'Player of the Season'!

After an amazing 10 years at Portsmouth FC I can honestly say I owe everything to God and my life

Life is full of uncertainty. I can say that without fear of contradiction. That has been my experience both in

no apparent reason sometimes plunging us into turmoil, uncertainty, even hopelessness.

However, since I became a Christian and have a personal relationship with God I have found that He is an unchanging

rock in my life. No matter what is happening I know that He is with me through every change and storm of life and His promise of peace in my heart and mind give me a certainty of hope nothing else in life has ever done!

Crashing into Heaven

Stuart Braye Paraplegic Olympic Medal Winner



was born in 1958. Our family were not Christians and we never had prayers, Bible stories or church attendance. A normal family. I joined the Army and enlisted in the Royal Corps of Signals. In my final year in the Army I was attached to the Special Air Service in the 264 (SAS) Signal Squadron.

About a year prior to this my brother Charles and his family became Christians. Late one evening in 1981 I was bragging about how fit I was and he was telling me about Jesus. Having almost convinced me that Heaven was a good place, he said that Heaven was a good place, he said that the only way to get there was to, "ask Jesus to come into your life." I said that I would do that "just before I die".

I left the Army in 1981 to marry my wife Marion the following year, and began work driving articulated heavy goods vehicles. In March 1985, on my way to Glasgow, as I approached a traffic jam on the M6, the brakes on my lorry completely failed. In a split second I thought, "This is it! I'm dead!" But I forgot my promise to ask Jesus into my life.

My right leg was completely crushed. In hospital my leg was amputated below the knee. Awesome!! What followed was a decade of ups and downs as I struggled badly to cope with life as a disabled person. Physically, however, I did well. I was quickly lifting weights and getting into athletics with other amputees.

By 1991 I was the fourth fastest below knee amputee in the World and the fastest European over 100, 200 and

400 metres. In 1992 I won a Bronze medal in the 400 metres at the Barcelona Paralympic Games. I had gained a Masters Degree in Sports Management and a secure job working in sports development. My family was great and we had a really nice house. I seemed to have



everything, but inside I was a total mess. Depressed, lonely, unhappy, unloving, not scoring very highly as a husband or dad and not liking myself very much. But a wonderful change was very near.

On 9th January 1996 my brother was diagnosed with cancer. He was peaceful and grateful for his life. I was a mess. After my first visit to see him I went to bed. Suddenly I remembered, "To become a Christian ask Jesus to come into your life." So that is exactly what I did, quietly but audibly. I woke up the next day a totally different person. Marion says that I went to visit my brother like a cross between Arnold Schwarzenegger and Rambo and the next morning I was a cross between John the Baptist and Cliff Richard!

> It is very hard to describe the change in me. Now I knew God, I knew I was forgiven for my sins. I knew Jesus, I was filled with the Holy Spirit. I was a new person. Still me but a much better me. I felt God tell me not to worry about my family or say too much. A year after this Marion became a Christian and our boys, then aged 11 and 13, made their first commitment. They are strong Christians today. Mike a worship leader and Andy a preacher.

God has never let us down. Marion has survived breast cancer; Andy survived a tour of Iraq with the Parachute Regiment. I now work as a Senior Lecturer in Sports Sociology at Teesside University. Life has been tough at times, but the last 16 years with Jesus have been the best. When things appear to go wrong, Jesus just gets closer. I hope you do as I did and ask Jesus to come into your life. You won't regret it!

Saved to Serve

Michael Lapage – Silver Medal winner in the 1948 Olympics


n 1939, after securing a place at Cambridge, I was called up to start training in the Navy as a Fleet Air Arm pilot. Kneeling to pray in a barrack room took a bit of determination. My brother had advised me, "Let it be known immediately just whom you trust in." No boots came flying. In fact a hush descended on the dormitory. The next day two other recruits came to suggest we meet for prayer.

The next step was to learn how to land a Seafire (the naval version of the Spitfire) on the small deck of an escort carrier. The in-line engine gave it a long nose which had to be raised for landing at 68 knots. The stalling speed was 63 knots and it meant opening the cockpit hood and coming in on a curved approach with one eye on the batsman on deck and the other on the airspeed and altitude. In April 1944, 807 Squadron joined the Carrier HMS Hunter in the Mediterranean. Seafires were wonderful in the air, but we had casualties. Over Southern France my wing man went down in flames. Next year, in the Pacific Fleet, I had a Japanese Zero on my tail; part of it was shot away. Why had I been spared? Perhaps because the Lord had work for me to do after the war. "Saved to serve"

At Cambridge, in January 1946, J took up rowing again, having in my rowed school VIII. I was selected for the University crew in 1948, a recordbreaking year. Then, with verv little warning, the Olympic Games appeared on the horizon and my Cambridge crew was finally selected



to represent GB. We went through to win silver medals, losing only to a strong and well-fed crew from California University!

The calling to put Christ first led me to ioin the Church Missionary Society. but first I was advised to find a post in the UK for a year's experience. It turned out to be two happy years at Winchester College, coaching the school VIII. The crew won the Schools' Head of the River race at Putney, and the Princess Elizabeth Cup at Henley. The temptation to accept an offer to stay on had to be resisted! So I went to Kenya teaching in a school right on the Equator. Nearby was a Bible School where the Principal's daughter was about to attend the same Kenya Keswick Convention that I had booked

in for! We were engaged a week later and married following the vear. both convinced of the Lord's leading. Μv reputation changed from being an Olympic oarsman to that of Canon Butcher's son-inlaw, a good knock to my pride.

One day, on the way back from visiting a remote school, I came to a sandy river-bed

crossing. Half way across, the car sank gently on to its belly. It was 7 miles each way to get help and I was on my own, or so I thought. Nothing for it but to walk, but first a short prayer. After walking for five minutes I saw, to my astonishment, a detachment of the British Army out on a training exercise with heavy moving equipment. They got my car back on the road in a matter of minutes. "Thank you, Lord," I breathed inwardly and outwardly to the Army, for answering my prayer so quickly.


I hope my story shows that we have a prayer answering God who helps us when we call upon Him. But first we have to get to know Him, and that is only a prayer away.

had been boxing since I was eight years old, and the Olympics were my lifelong dream. I was twenty three years old and had been following Jesus for about two years and growing stronger in His love every day.

I was on my way to the Olympic Games in 1996 – at least that is what I thought. I had my gear, my Bible and my spiritual pastor, Cliff Hancock. I felt unbeatable. The tournament was a double elimination, meaning you can lose one and still have another chance to make it. My first opponent was Michael Nunnley. During the bout, I was doing well, but not what I know I was capable of doing. I ended up losing the match. I didn't understand why I wasn't boxing up to my potential; but I still had another chance at my dream.

I really wanted to go out in the next match and win. My opponent was Darnell Wilson. But, then something happened. I couldn't get off. I was slow and sluggish. I boxed just fine, but again... not fine enough. I was defeated, and my Olympic dreams were crushed. I didn't understand. I thought that this was what God wanted for me.



I flew home the next day and my parents tried to comfort me all day, but I wasn't being very cooperative. The next day was Easter Sunday, and I said they could come to church with me if they wanted. They had never attended church before and were a little hesitant, but went with me anyway.


The next morning as I sat in the congregation and watched my parents devote their own lives to Jesus for the first time, I realised that God had given me the best gift of all. Sure, I wasn't at the Olympics winning a gold medal, but on the Easter Sunday, 30 March, 1996, I wasn't supposed to be at the Olympics. Instead, God wanted me there – in church – witnessing my parents becoming real born again Christians. My family were baptised all together later that month.

That was more precious than the Gold Medal I might have won.

My family and I are very blessed having Jesus as our Friend. I ended my amateur career losing to the 1996 Olympic gold medallist. I was blessed to beat two Olympic bronze medallists, Germaine Taylor and Roshi Wells. They both went on to have great careers, Germaine Taylor becoming the world's undisputed middle weight champion.

I have been blessed with a great wife and three wonderful boys. I have never looked back in regret. Through my many accomplishments and my many mistakes, I have learned to walk the path God has for me not the path I want to walk. As God tells us in Philippians 4:13, "I can do all things through Christ who strengthens me."


