Women of FGB Specific Aims

- To pray regularly for all aspects of FGB & WoF (local, regional, national and global).

- Enable WoF members to be involved in ministry to women alongside the men of FGB.
- Organise and participate in local, regional and national events for Women of FGR
- To encourage the spiritual growth of women through fellowship and ministering to one another.
- To bring glory and honour to Christ Jesus.

Activities and Organisation of WoF

While supporting, encouraging and praying for the men of FGB, organised WoF events give women of all ages and backgrounds an opportunity to come alongside, make new friends and hear real life experiences of how God is working to transform lives and families.

WoF members meet for fellowship, prayer, ministry one to another and sharing testimonies. Where the occasion allows, teaching and developing ministries to women are organised within the backing

and approval of the officers of the relevant local FGB Chapter, Regional Council or National Council as appropriate.

With events such as prayer gatherings, fellowship/testimony meetings, in homes or other public venues over breakfast, coffee and cake, etc. provide good opportunities to introduce our friends to FGB.

Regional and National events are arranged by WoF Coordinators.
